School & Nursery Uniform

Thank you for your continued support, the children are looking wonderful in their school and nursery uniforms. The school uniform helps ensure that they are very distinctive to the local community and brings a sense of belonging to the school.

Home Learning - Starting Monday 4th September

Home Learning activities reinforce the skills and knowledge children are taught within the class. Home Learning will be issued weekly, starting on Monday 4th September. Home Learning will include activities which focus on Literacy, Numeracy & Maths, Health & Wellbeing, and other areas of the Curriculum, with a variety of written and active learning tasks.

Children will be issued with all the relevant usernames and passwords to allow access. Home Learning will be issued on Monday and returned by Friday each week. Home Learning is an important aspect of your child's learning, and we would encourage all parents to participate fully in their children's Home Learning.

Pupils will be working with their teachers this week, Monday 4th September, to set their Learning Targets in Literacy, Numeracy and Health & Wellbeing for this Term.
