Primary 7 Transition Event



Please look out for an order slip in your eldest child's bag week beginning Monday 4th December. (Families may wish to swap tickets to allow 2 family members to come to one performance.) It is anticipated that all ticket allocation will be used. If there are any spare tickets, we will let families know and draw names from a hat for any spare tickets.

Wednesday 13th December ~ School Pupils to 'Sleeping Senga' Pantomime

Primary 1 – 7 will go to see 'Sleeping Senga' at East Kilbride Village Theatre. There will be **no** charge for all pupils as the cost is being covered by our Pupil Equity Fund. Please note that the show is in the morning, during school.
